Beginning at midnight on Monday, February 6, through, and ending at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, April 28th. Parents must submit applications online or directly to the nonresident school district. It is recommended that you submit your application as early as possible during the application period. Late applications will **NOT** be accepted for any reason. If you miss the deadline, you are still able to apply through the Alternative Open Enrollment Application Process which begins July 1, 2017.
