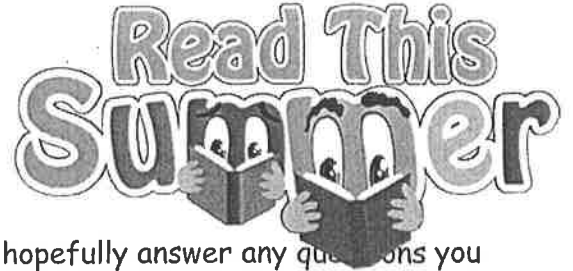


Parents and Students,



We are excited to announce that we will be having our 3rd Annual Summer Reading Program for Theresa Learning Community and Lomira Elementary School students. This letter has information on how the summer reading program works and will hopefully answer any questions you might have. Our Summer Reading Program will run from June 7 through September 2, 2019. We have attached an example reading log as a reference as to how to record the different types of activities. There are two different point systems (K-2nd and 3rd-5th), depending on the grade your child will be entering in the fall.

- Incoming Kindergarten through 2nd grade students will receive 1 point every time they read or are read to for 10 minutes.
- Incoming 3rd through 5th grade students will receive 1 point for every 20 minutes of reading.
- All students will receive:
 - 3 points for taking and passing a RAZ-Kids quiz and/or EPIC quiz (students have certain accounts depending on grade and teacher; incoming Kindergarten students do not have RAZ-kids or EPIC accounts YET) (If you need your login, please contact your classroom teacher.).
 - 2 points for visiting a library to check out books and/or attend a library event and getting a librarian's initials (maximum 2 pts per visit).
 - 10 points for participating in a public library's reading program (Students must receive a certificate from library program and attach to their reading log.).

Students need to earn 75 or more points to be invited to the summer reading program celebration in September. Only those students who have earned 75 points and turn in their completed logs will receive an invitation to the celebration, which will take place during the school day. Students who do not reach 75 points will have the opportunity to participate in literacy activities in the classroom.

Reading is valued in the Lomira School District, and we want your child to continue to grow in their reading abilities. We have created this program to help them to continue growing as readers and to help prevent the "summer slide".

We have enclosed several reading logs for your child to use during the summer. If you need more of these logs throughout the summer, they will be in the Lomira Elementary School Office and also at the Lomira, Brownsville and Theresa Public Libraries. We will also post reading logs on our district website that you can print from home.

We are so excited to see all of the reading and other literacy activities that will be done this summer! Reading logs can be turned into your classroom teachers at school supply drop off or on the first day of school. Have a great summer and keep reading!

Summer Reading Program Incentives

The top point earners from the Kindergarten-2nd grade and 3rd-5th grade divisions will receive:

- A **pizza party** lunch with Mrs. Schaefer
- Two **"Fast Passes"** to redeem at the Summer Reading Celebration in September**
- **\$10** to spend at the fall **book fair**
- **Recognition** at a school-wide assembly



A "Fast Pass" allows students to move to the front of any ONE line during the Summer Reading Celebration. "Fast Passes" **must be turned in with students' reading logs. Lost or late "Fast Passes" will not be honored.

"Talk with a Teacher"

Visit one of the local libraries during the following times to **talk and read with a teacher**, as well as receive one free **"Fast Pass"** at each visit. You may earn a maximum of three "Fast Passes" throughout the summer by attending "Talk with a Teacher" events.

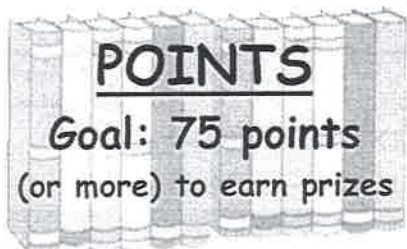
