We are excited to announce that we will be having our 2nd Annual Summer Reading Program for Theresa Learning Community and Lomira Elementary School students. This letter has information on how the summer reading program works and will hopefully answer any questions you might have. Read through it carefully and if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact Ms. Gumz (tgumz@lomira.k12.wi.us) or Ms. Gibbons (mgibbons@lomira.k12.wi.us).

Our summer reading program will run from June 5th 2018 through August 31st 2018. We have attached an example reading log as a reference as to how to record the different types of activities. There are two different point systems (K-2nd and 3rd-5th) depending on the grade your child will be entering in the fall.

- Kindergarten through 2nd grade students will receive 1 point every time they read or are read to for 10 minutes.
- 3rd through 5th grade students will receive 1 point for every 20 minutes of reading.
- All students will receive:
 - 3 point for taking and Passing a RAZ-Kids quiz
 - 2 points for visiting a library to check out books and/or attend a library event and getting a librarian's initials

A student needs to earn 75 or more points to be invited to the summer reading program celebration in September. Only those students who have earned 75 points will receive an invitation to the celebration, which will take place during the school day. Students who do not reach 75 points will participate in literacy activities in the classroom.

Reading is valued in the Lomira School District and we want your child to continue to grow in their reading abilities. We have created this program to help them to continue growing as readers and to help prevent the "summer slide" that is often seen.

We have enclosed several reading logs for your child to use during the summer. If you need more of these logs throughout the summer, they will be in the Lomira Elementary School Office and also at the Lomira, Brownsville and Theresa Public Libraries. We will also post reading logs on our district website that you can print from home.

We are so excited to see all of the reading and other literacy activities that will be done this summer! Reading logs can be turned in to your classroom teachers at school supply drop off or on the first day of school. Have a great summer and keep reading!

Nos complace anunciar que tendremos nuestro segundo Programa Anual de Lectura de Verano para los estudiantes de Theresa Learning Community y Lomira Elementary School. Esta carta contiene información sobre cómo funciona el programa de lectura de verano y con suerte responderá cualquier pregunta que pueda tener. Nuestro programa de lectura de verano se ejecutará desde el 5 de junio de 2018 hasta el 31 de agosto de 2018. Hemos adjuntado un registro de lectura de ejemplo como referencia sobre cómo registrar los diferentes tipos de actividades. Hay dos sistemas de puntos diferentes (K-2nd y 3rd-5th) dependiendo del grado al que ingresará su hijo en el otoño.

- *Los estudiantes de **Kínder a Segundo grado** recibirán 1 punto cada vez que lean o lean durante 10 minutos.
- *Los estudiantes de **3 ° a 5 ° grado** recibirán 1 punto por cada 20 minutos de lectura.
- ***Todos** los estudiantes recibirán:
 - 3 puntos por tomar y aprobar una prueba de RAZ-Kids
 - 2 puntos por visitar una biblioteca para sacar libros y / o asistir a un evento de la biblioteca y obtener las iniciales de un bibliotecario

Un estudiante necesita ganar 75 o más puntos para ser invitado a la celebración del programa de lectura de verano en septiembre. Solo aquellos estudiantes que hayan obtenido 75 puntos recibirán una invitación a la celebración, que tendrá lugar durante el día escolar. Los estudiantes que no alcanzan los 75 puntos participarán en actividades de alfabetización en el aula.

La lectura es valorada en el Distrito Escolar de Lomira y queremos que su hijo continúe creciendo en sus habilidades de lectura. Hemos creado este programa para ayudarlos a seguir creciendo como lectores y para ayudar a prevenir el "deslizamiento de verano" que a menudo se ve.

Hemos incluido varios registros de lectura para que su hijo los use durante el verano. Si necesita más de estos registros durante el verano, estarán en la Oficina de la Escuela Primaria Lomira y también en las Bibliotecas Públicas de Lomira, Brownsville y Theresa. También publicaremos registros de lectura en el sitio web de nuestro distrito que puede imprimir desde su hogar.

¡Estamos muy emocionados de ver todas las actividades de lectura y otras actividades de alfabetización que se realizarán este verano! Los registros de lectura se pueden entregar a los maestros de la clase en la entrega de suministros escolares o en el primer día de clases. ¡Que tengas un gran verano y sigas leyendo!

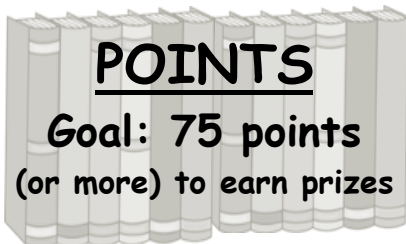
