2018-2019 OPEN ENROLLMENT

The open enrollment application period for the 2018-2019 school year is from February 5-April 30, 2018. Parents must submit applications online or directly to the non-resident school district. For more information contact Ann at 269-4396 ext. 107. Online applications are available <https://apps4.dpi.wi.gov/Opal2012>. It is recommended that you submit your application as early as possible during the application period. If you miss the deadline, you are still able to apply through the Alternative Open Enrollment Application Process which begins July 1, 2018.
