**\*\* Many of our Junior students did very well on their ACT exams this spring and have therefore earned an exemption from taking some of their final exams if they choose to. Students who have earned individualized exemptions will be notified. They will have a form in mid-May to share with you regarding the finals that they, personally, can exempt. ## Frequently asked questions that you & your parents may be wondering about:

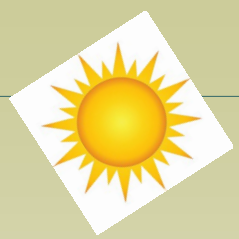
- ◆ **Unexcused absences and disciplinary issues during 2nd semester of your senior year WILL impact your ability to participate** in the ceremony. Keep attending and keep your behaviors positive and mature—as we would expect from all soon-to-be adults!
- ◆ If your child is NOT planning to attend the senior trip on May 22nd, they **MUST** be at school, in attendance in their classes, for the entire day. Professional, medical excuses only if absent!
- ◆ Seniors last academic day for school attendance is Thursday, May 23rd.
- ◆ Caps & gowns were delivered to students weeks ago. Be sure to hang those gowns to get the wrinkles out. **This is an important & formal event.... appropriate attire is required for all graduates** to participate in the ceremony.
- ◆ Graduation Practice is **mandatory** for those who plan to be in the ceremony. All students must be in the high school gym by 8 am on Friday, May 24th. Any outstanding fees & school payments **MUST** be paid prior to practice beginning.
- ◆ Graduation is at 6:00 on Friday, May 24th.
- ◆ Graduates must **be in the math hallway by 5:30 pm** for formal line-up.
- ◆ **Bring as many guests as you want** to the graduation ceremony. Only 4 tickets will be allowed for floor seating but the bleachers are open to all.
